Our Mission

We are committed to providing exceptional instruction, education and support to ensure that children and adults achieve their potential in life. We believe that each individual is extraordinary and through our extraordinary efforts they will achieve a more independent and successful future.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

****Intensive and structured 12-month educational programming from 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM for students in 9th Grade through 12th Grade.**

****Curriculum and instructional programs aligned with NYS Learning Standards and the Next Generation Standards**

****An Individualized Education Plan (IEP) is developed and implemented for each student, including strategies and goals tailored to their academic and social needs**

****Rigorous, language-based learning in small classrooms with low student-to-teacher ratios: 12 students, 1 certified special education teacher, and 3 teaching assistants (12:1:3)**

****Transdisciplinary model focused on language development, enhancing each student’s social, emotional, cognitive, and language skills**

****School-Wide Behavior Plan which encourages appropriate social skills, in the form of a token economy**

****Reading Specialist and reading services offered for diagnostic purposes and additional reading support**

****Individual Speech and Language Therapy**

****Family and community support, including Parent Training**

****All high school students receive Tiegerman-issued Chromebooks**

****On-site support from a Behavior Specialist and Registered Behavior Technicians (RBTs)**

****Assistive Technology (H.A.T, tablets, etc.)**



Tiegerman Transition NYC Program

This program is an individualized program for individuals 17-21 with learning differences. The primary goal is to enhance individuals’ employability by participating in internships to strengthen their career readiness.

Tiegerman Transition NYC’s hybrid model includes daily internship experiences, while incorporating career readiness courses that actively prepare individuals for the workforce. Individuals develop the foundational skills necessary for a successful transition to a career path that aligns to their skill set.

SUMMER PROGRAM

In addition to our commitment to academic excellence, Tiegerman recognizes the need for involvement in extra-curricular pursuits. During our six-week summer program, our students engage in activities of interest which showcase their creative talents.

Vocational Pathways

COMPUTER ARTS

This pathway is designed to educate students on aspects of art technology. This pathway exposes students to the various fields of design and art. Students receive hands on experience with computer software that is used in all aspects of design.

FAMILY & CONSUMER SCIENCE

This pathway is designed to expose students to the principles of nutrition and its relationship to the foodservice industry. Topics include personal nutrition fundamentals, weight management, exercise, nutritional adaptation/analysis of recipes/menus, healthy cooking techniques and marketing nutrition in a foodservice operation. In addition, this pathway exposes students to child /adult care.

BUSINESS OFFICE TECHNOLOGY

This pathway is designed to expose students to all aspects of office technology, including instruction on the operation of office equipment and procedures. Students will develop an awareness of different types of technology, understand how this technology affects society and the workforce, and use technology to acquire, organize, and communicate information.

Media Arts and Technology

This pathway is designed to expose students to the principals of digital media and its relationship to the workforce. Topics include digital video, animation, video editing, media production and broadcast communications. Students are exposed to the latest technologies utilized by businesses and industries to allow students hands-on experience necessary for future success.

Retail Marketing

This pathway is designed to educate students on all the aspects of retail marketing in our fully equipped Calvin Klein & Tommy Hilfiger store. The students are exposed to inventory control, setup design, cashiering, and loss prevention. They are taught about the operations of retail establishments, related technology, and will become able to demonstrate an understanding of business, marketing, and economic concepts.

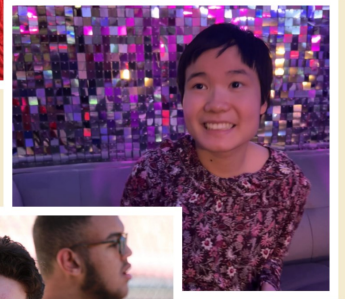
